Wine Introduction

Cuvée elaborated in honor of Petrus Lambertini who became the first Mayor of Bordeaux elected by the aldermen of Bordeaux in 1208. Lambertini defended the city of Bordeaux against the King of Spain in 1208. For his heroism he was congratulated by the King of England, John Lackland. Our wine, is a piece of the story of Bordeaux and also of the history of England.

In his honor, the best grapes of the best vineyard parcels in Bordeaux have been selected to develop an exceptional wine that bears his name today.

Coureau & Coureau, iconic winemakers in Bordeaux, maintain tradition in their continued elaboration of this 'grand vin'.

Tasting Notes

The wine has cherry red that combines hot tones and bright lime. In the nose, generous notes of red fruit flourishing in a harmonious combination of spice and floral scents. Flexible in its approach, easy on the palate, some slender.
